WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The program is open to active and retired members of The SCEA, their spouses, domestic partners, children (including stepchildren and children-in-law), financial dependents, siblings, parents, and grandchildren. Family members do NOT need to be financial dependents or living with the member to be eligible.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

Students who have earned an Associate Degree or 60+ college credits with a 2.2 CGPA are eligible for the Career Plus program at Central State University. Students not yet meeting that requirement can begin with Eastern Gateway Community College and then transfer into the Bachelor's Degree Completion Program at Central State University.
