

The SCEA State Delegates Accountability System

- a. State delegates will be penalized for not being in attendance at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the time. The delegates will be assessed a financial penalty equal to time lost greater than twenty-five percent (25%) of stated attendance requirement. The SCEA President shall have the authority to make exceptions in cases *of* extreme emergency (i.e. in delegate's immediate family, illness of the delegate).
- b. State NEA delegates will receive the delegate allotment at the first caucus meeting.
- c. Any state delegate not attending the convention due to an emergency must reimburse the Association within thirty (30) days.
- d. The attendance records for state NEA delegates will be filed in the Association office immediately upon return to the state. These records will be kept for a period of one year.
